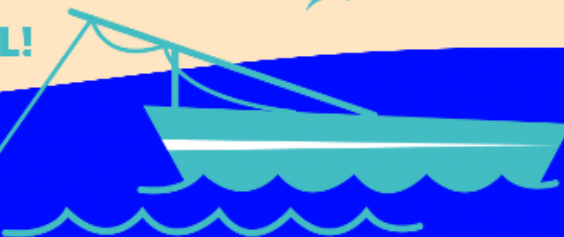

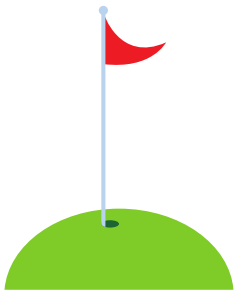

This is a catch, photo, and release tournament consisting of one (1) Snook, one (1) Redfish and one (1) Trout of unlimited size for the day. Winner determined by most total inches. Each team will be provided a tournament ruler. Teams will be required to email photos for judging to: fishing@fi-florida.org

Fishing Times

Saturday: Honor start 7:30am, Measure in 4:00pm

Prizes

Prize money awarded for 1st-3rd overall for the team with the most inches by 4pm. 1st place-\$4000, 2nd place-\$2000, 3rd place-\$1000

Cost

Entry fee is \$200 per angler and includes Captain's Meeting on Friday and dinner at the Shrimp Dock on Saturday after the tournament. Additional tickets for the Captain's Meeting or dinner may be purchased separately.

Rules

1. Knowing the rules is an important part of the tournament. At least one member from each team will be required to read and sign that they understand the rules and will abide by them throughout the competition. If you see another team behaving improperly, please be sure to photograph/document and bring to the official's attention right away.
2. The tournament is a team format with each team allowed to enter a maximum **of one redfish, one snook and one trout**. Each team may

photograph as many fish as necessary but only the largest of each species will be counted. All lengths will be rounded up to the nearest inch (i.e. a 24 3/8" will be rounded up to 25" and will be scored accordingly). Pinching the tail is required for snook. The winner will be determined by most total inches.

3. Measuring and photographing the fish with the tournament ruler with the Angler number, and releasing a live fish constitutes a catch. The fish must face left on the measuring board. Any deviation from the above photographing techniques will result in no points for that catch. To assure a successful release, please make every effort to return each fish back to the water as soon as possible.

4. Fishing Times: Honor start 7:30AM – Rods out 3:30PM – Photo Review 4:00PM

5. All boats must start at starting time or after. An early start or late arrival disqualifies the boat.

6. There are no minimum size restrictions for any species.

7. Tiebreaker for the tournament will be awarded to the team that caught their last fish entered, earliest in the tournament.

8. Only 1 working rod per angler is allowed in the water at any time

9. There must be two anglers on every participating boat. In the absence of a teammate, the tournament committee will appoint a substitute angler.

10. All State fishing and boating laws apply; Slow zones and other boating regulations must be observed. No trailering during tournament hours. It is recommended that anglers wear Personal Flotation Devices while the boat's motor is moving.

11. All fish must be caught by hook and line.

12. Maximum test leader 40lbs.

13. Artificial, dead or live baits allowed.

14. No bait furnished during tournament hours.

15. No double or treble hooks except on artificial lures.

16. No snatch or snag hooking.
17. No pet fish.
18. Maximum double line 36", maximum leader 36".
19. Teams may wade or fish from shore; however, the boat must be at anchor the entire time any angler is fishing outside the boat. No spotting/hole sitting.
20. No fishing is permitted within 200 feet of a facility that sells bait and/or fuel. No fishing public or private marinas or boat ramps.
21. A boat may assist a disabled tournament member boat and be late to weigh in and not be disqualified. The disabled boat, however, is disqualified.
22. No angler at any time may alter any fish by length or weight with the intention of gaining advantage over another competing team. In addition, no angler may hand or force any tournament fish.
23. Good sportsmanship is expected, however, the penalty for any violation of the rules is disqualification. All protests must be signed and in writing and given to the Tournament Director by 4:00 pm the day of the event. The Site Director will contact the Tournament Rules Committee for a decision. All decisions by the Rules Committee are final.
